Study Animal Law in the United States

Scholarships for individuals who demonstrate a keen interest in the field of animal law. CALs offers the most extensive animal law curriculum in the world and the only LL.M. degree program. This program is designed for U.S. and international law school graduates who wish to focus on animal law in practice, teaching, research, or public policy.

The Scholarship is designed to support lawyers, scholars, judges, government officials, and advocates who wish to further their education in order to become their countries' innovators and leaders in work such as protecting wildlife or prosecuting animal cruelty.

Our Scholarships include:

- Full waiver of tuition
- On-campus student housing
- Partial meal-plan while classes are in session
- Health insurance
- One round-trip international airline ticket

The Scholarships do not cover additional course costs, such as books or other activities.

Interested in Applying?

To be eligible for the scholarship, applicants must first meet the admission criteria set forth in the application to the LL.M. Program. In addition to the completed application, applicants must also submit a 1 to 3 page Letter of Intent expressing their interest in the Scholarship and explaining the particular circumstances of why they should be considered for scholarship support. Scholarships are awarded on the basis of academic merit, financial need, as well as the applicant's personal statement in response to questions detailed in the LL.M. application. Applicants should demonstrate a sincere interest or relevant experience in animal law or related areas.

Preference will be given to qualified applicants from African countries, but all international candidates are strongly encouraged to apply.
